This 21 ha park includes over 10 hectares of native bushland, offering fabulous bird viewing including the Eurasian Coot.

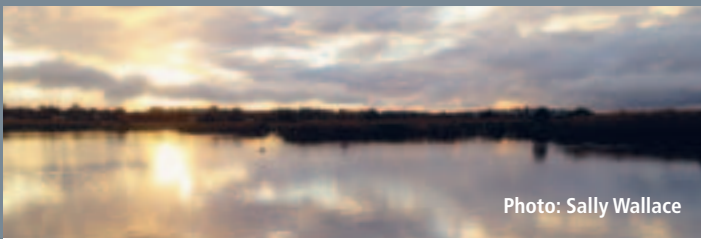

Enjoy stunning views of the city. Local Noongar people used the lakes for resources and as a meeting place, with up to 400 people recorded in corroborees here.

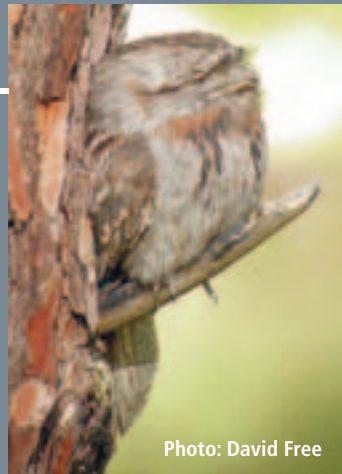

Situated about 5 km upstream from the mouth of the river at Fremantle, much of the bay's foreshore on the western and eastern sides are limestone cliffs.
